BYLAW 49-2020 2021 FEES, RATES, AND CHARGES BYLAW

The *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c M-26 (the "MGA") provides that a municipality may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting services, licences, permits, approvals, and utility services provided by the municipality; and

Section 8 of the MGA allows a municipality to set fees for licences, permits, approvals, and utility services provided by the municipality;
