Intergenerational community recreation and activity centre that supports the County's vision, and the design is inspired by "becoming Canada's most livable community."







- Community recreation and activity centre for users of all ages that accommodates a wide spectrum of activities









How likely would a household member participate in an activity that uses **indoor turf field**?




How likely would a household member use multi-use courts spaces?




Yes, my household would potentially use the track or multi-purpose rooms




Would you support the development of an indoor fieldhouse for Strathcona County?


# **Q** Gate 2 proposed funding

- Up to \$5 million for detailed design and project management resources to be included in the 2021 capital budget process
  - Paid for by municipal reserves, no 2021 tax implication
- Administration is evaluating the funding options for the full project financing
  - Reserve funding, debentures, grants, user fees, partnership or agreements
  - Confirmation of financing strategy in 2021

- GATE 1 APPROVAL: Facility concept October 27, 2020 (Option 4 approved)
- GATE 2 APPROVAL: Detailed design and project management resources, up to a maximum of \$5 November 24, 2020

- GATE 4 APPROVAL: Final building approval, Q2-Q4, 2021
