

# Parkade Incident (Community Centre) Cost Update – July 23, 2019

## **Report Purpose**

To provide Council an update on the increased cost estimates for the Community Centre restoration project for consideration and approval.

#### Recommendation

THAT an increase of \$1,000,000 (from \$14,000,000 to \$15,000,000), to be funded from municipal reserve and insurance reimbursements, for the restoration work following the November 6, 2018 incident, be approved.

#### Report

Following the November 6, 2018 incident, as the remediation and assessment of costs has continued, it is now evident that the total costs for full restoration and damages are over the initial \$14,000,000 estimate. The original estimate was based on early assessments with lots of unknowns. The updated estimates can be summarized as follows:

To date \$9.9m has been reimbursed from insurance proceeds. Strathcona County continues to work with the insurers towards as full a recovery as possible. When this process is complete, further update and information will be brought forward to Council.

November 27, 2018 Council approved the costs for the restoration of the Community 2018 Centre, Parkade and County Hall in the amount of \$14,000,000 with funding from insurance for all eligible costs and the R2 Municipal Contingency Reserve for ineligible costs; and if interim funding is required, that \$8,000,000 from the R2 Contingency Reserve and \$6,000,000 from the R3 Municipal Projects Reserve was approved.
