RE: Council Priority Funds Application

The Ardrossan Strathcona Figure Skating Club (ASFSC) is looking for additional funding to put towards the costs of 'Spiritwear' for the Clubs skaters that are involved in the PreStarSkate and StarSkate programs. In the past we have ordered on-ice warm up jackets and hoodies, but are also looking at toques and skating gloves. Each item would have the club's logo embroidered on the items and a skater's name. These skaters wear this attire on the ice during practice sessions, as well as during warm ups at test days and competitions.

The Club is wanting to keep the skater's costs to a minimum and are hoping to raise/receive about \$500 that would cover about half the cost of the attire for the skaters. The Club plans to contribute an equal amount in the hopes of being able to provide this Spiritwear to the skaters at minimal to no cost.

We currently have 18 skaters that would be part of the StarSkate and PreStarSkate programs and are looking at an expense of \$75 per skater, so our total would be \$1350. If we were to receive the \$500 from the Council Priority Funds, and the Club contributes another \$500, then each skater would only be needing to spend \$20 towards the Spiritwear.
