Report

This report will share research conducted by the Seniors Advisory Committee on a seniors hub concept. The following are 2020 mandate items that support the committee's research on a seniors hub:

- Identify and recommend how seniors' issues may be addressed in various County initiatives and strategies for supporting active and engaged seniors.
- Engage or liaise with seniors' stakeholder groups to seek feedback on seniors' issues and opportunities and to access the most current and pertinent information to facilitate discussions and recommendations.
- Recommend seniors issues that could benefit from broader public engagement.

The purpose of the Seniors Advisory Committee (SAC) is to provide advice and considerations to Council on issues and opportunities related to the physical, emotional and social wellbeing of seniors in Strathcona County. The SAC provides a seniors' lens to Council and Administration on Strathcona County policies, programs and services to improve outcomes for seniors in Strathcona County.
