Report

The funding approach set out in the 2018 Social Framework Community Grants policy supports collaboration, learning, creativity and innovation. There are two types of funding for social sector organizations:

- Core Funding of 1 – 3 years supports the social non-profit sector in providing prevention and early intervention supports for social needs and in contributing to the Social Framework outcomes,
- Collaboration Funding of 2 – 3 years mobilizes cross-sector partnerships and collective resources to address community-wide social issues.

Core and collaboration funding are granted through an annual grant competition, with final decisions on allocations made by Council.
