We do not currently have a specific rebate program for homeowners for energy efficiency upgrades/retrofits. Administration is reviewing opportunities and will provide a specific report on options for energy retrofits by the end of September 2021 as directed by Council at the February 2nd meeting. 5-2021	Information	DELAINEY Linton	Community Hall Security	Please provide an overview of the electronic surveillance equipment and security measures currently in place for each of the County's community halls with an indication of what the County's responsibilities are in providing and maintaining security equipment and providing services that ensure they remain secure at all times.	Facility Services	Recreation, Parks and Culture	Under the community hall operating license, the community groups are responsible to secure the premise. A few of the community halls have a security alarm system installed that are either monitored remotely by a contracted monitoring station or have localized alarm sirens. Under the license, the County does not have a contractual requirement to ensure the facilities are always secure. Community groups are responsible to insure the renters of facilities keep the building secure after use and to ensure attractive items like alcohol, audio-visual equipment or other attractive items are properly secured or removed from the facility to reduce the risk of break ins.  The County does have an obligation to ensure the door locking hardware and exterior lighting are maintained.
