

Bylaw 8-2021 Road Closure (Ward 7)

Report Purpose

To give three readings to a bylaw that proposes a closure of a portion of original government road allowance within NW 1-52-21-W4.

Recommendations

- 1. THAT Bylaw 8-2021, a bylaw that closes a portion of original government road allowance, within NW 1-52-21-W4, be given first reading.
- 2. THAT Bylaw 8-2021 be given second reading.
- 3. THAT Bylaw 8-2021 be considered for third reading.
- 4. THAT Bylaw 8-2021 be given third reading.

Our Prioritized Strategic Goals

Report

The road right-of-way, which is undeveloped, is located on an unnamed island situated on North Cooking Lake.

The applicant, who owns the majority of the lands abutting the undeveloped road allowance, has approached the County to consider closing the portion of road allowance so that they control access to their property.

The undeveloped portion of the road allowance is not required and can be closed and consolidated into the adjacent lot.

Other Impacts

Policy: n/a

Legislative/Legal: Section 22 of the *Municipal Government Act* allows for the closure of a road by bylaw after advertising and allowing any persons (or their agents) who claim to be prejudicially affected to be heard by Council.

Interdepartmental: The proposal was circulated with internal and external stakeholders. All concerns received have been addressed.
