## Report Purpose

In compliance with Bylaw 46-2015, this report summarizes annual activities and accomplishments of the Community Living Advisory Committee for 2020.

## Report

The purpose of the Community Living Advisory Committee (CLAC) is to consider and recommend actions and propose policies that enhance community life and are in alignment with the social and cultural pillars of sustainability as set out on Strathcona County Council's strategic plan, and social and cultural priority areas and strategic goals as identified by Strathcona County Council from time to time.

The following are the mandate items undertaken by the CLAC in 2020:

- Provide input to Council on the effectiveness of the "community seed funding" stream, as per the Social Framework Community Grants policy.
- Provide input and advice on options, including a one-application process, for funding community playgrounds.
- Provide input and advice on opportunities for enhancing access to post-secondary programs in Strathcona County.
- Provide input and advice on opportunities to combat homelessness in Strathcona County.
