	<ul> <li>Consider providing the replacement schedules for playground publicly online – especially community playgrounds (especially because fundraising can take a long time)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Consider providing a mechanism to support people to donate</li> </ul>
	Consider provide coaching on fundraising



# Mandate Item: Combat Homelessness

<ul> <li>Received a presentation from the Alberta Rural Development Network</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Recommended that administration explore options to conduct a homelessness estimation</li> </ul>
	Youth homelessness is a significant concern
	Concern with the term "homeless"
	<ul> <li>Need more information on this topic – around youth needs, and the continuum of housing supports</li> </ul>



# Mandate Item: Connection and Change Grants

Activities	Highlights, Key Learnings, and Considerations
<ul> <li>Provided input on the administration of the Community Connection and Community Change Grants</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The varying grant amounts may be interfering with the planning of community events.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Consider limiting how often the same individuals can apply.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Better public communication and celebration about the grants, which will also promote other innovative projects and events.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Support the community to connect virtually instead of through block parties.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Any adjustments need to be communicated early in the process.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Formed a subcommittee with YAC to jointly navigate the connected mandate items</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Issues for students include: affordability, transit options, high-speed internet for rural students, affordable housing options, and resource lending options</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Submitted questions to the October mixed- topic SCOOP survey</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Would like to receive information about the status of this mandate item</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Organized a roundtable discussion in partnership with YAC about opportunities to enhance access to post secondary education in Strathcona County</li> </ul>
