- Airport City Solar – world's largest solar project at an airport
- Airport City Sustainability Campus being developed
  - Supporting economic diversity with focus on building back better
- Agricultural support a major part of the strategy
  - Support for food production, accessing national and global markets
  - Support of the Regional Agricultural Master Plan
- Working with a variety of partners to support more efficient planes and sustainable travel options



## CURRENT STATE

- Health and safety are top priorities – working closely with all levels of government on COVID-19
- Due to travel restrictions - domestic flights and international cargo only
  - Focus is on managing the impacts and supporting our partners, including airlines, to ensure EIA is ready for when flight restrictions lift
  - Expected to take several years to see pre-pandemic levels
  - EIA plays a key and ever-growing role in the supply chain as a gateway for medical PPE, vaccines, e-commerce and cargo products for our community and the North

- Continue our strong role in job creation and working together to develop economic growth opportunities for our region
