At the April 13, 2021 Council meeting, Council directed Administration to prepare a bylaw to amend bylaw 2-2021, the Performance Plan Committee Bylaw. In accordance with the direction provided by Council, Administration has prepared a bylaw which is provided as enclosure 1 of this report. Provided that Council is satisfied with the bylaw, Council may give the bylaw readings as noted in the recommendation section above.

THAT the Committee recommend to Council that Administration prepare a bylaw to amend Bylaw 2-2021 to:

- expand the mandate of the Committee to include ongoing measurement and reporting to Council on the Chief Commissioner Performance Plan, and
- to delete section 18 to allow the Committee to undertake the extended mandate.

January 19, 2021 Council gave Bylaw 2-2021, Chief Commissioner Performance Plan Committee Bylaw, three readings.

Other Impacts

Legislative/Legal: Section 145 of the *Municipal Government Act* provides that a council may pass bylaws in relation to the establishment and functions of council committees. Section 191 of the MGA provides that the power to pass a bylaw under legislation includes the power to amend or repeal. An amendment must be made in the same way as the original bylaw.
