- Having youth in positions of influence
- Ensuring youth feel their input is being used and valued

- Formed a subcommittee with CLAC to explore the connected mandate items
- Submitted questions to the October mixedtopic SCOOP survey about post-secondary access in Strathcona County
- Organized a roundtable discussion in partnership with the Community Living Advisory Committee about opportunities to enhance access to post secondary education in Strathcona County

- School related tools (technology, textbooks)


### Considerations to enhance post-secondary access:

- Enhance access to WIFI




### **Post Secondary Survey Results**

#### Top issue faced when attending post-secondary school




#### Barriers that prevented college/university attendance






### **Post Secondary Survey Results**

- Second-hand vapour
- Bill 19: the Tobacco and Smoking Amendment Act

- Education about the impacts of vaping
- Changing social norms around vaping
- Municipal policy (i.e., enhanced smoke-free areas and licensing)





# Mandate Item: Learning from Youth Focused Organizations

- Learned about the Fort Saskatchewan BRIDGE Wellness Hub for youth and the ways they are supporting youth
- Provided input to the Strathcona County Library as part of creating their new Plan of Service
