Our Prioritized Strategic Goals

Goal 7 - Provide opportunities for public engagement and communication

Rationale

Each year, members of the public are invited to apply for public member positions on council committees as well as external boards and committees. Typically, the County holds one recruitment in the fall; however, in some years a mini recruitment is required to fill a number of unexpected vacancies.

The Governance Advisory Committee is responsible to make timely recommendations to Council regarding the appointments and recommendations for appointments of public members. The Governance Advisory Committee reviewed applications, conducted interviews, and has determined its recommendations to Council for public member appointments.

This spring a mini-recruitment took place to address a small number of vacancies on various committees. As a result of this recruitment, all council committees will have full membership to carry out their work.
