

# Ardrossan Stage 8A park naming (Ward 5)

# **Report Purpose**

To provide Council with information on a proposed park name in Ardrossan Stage 8 within the Ardrossan East Area Structure Plan area.

#### Recommendation

THAT the "Hortonburg Park" be approved for the park name in Ardrossan Stage 8, as set out in Enclosure 3 of the June 15, 2021 Planning and Development report.

## Report

Hortonburg is an early community place name in Strathcona County, notably for a former post office in the Ardrossan area. Hortonburg Park will incorporate a stormwater management facility, a multi-use trail which will include a connection to the existing trail along the Pointe-Aux-Pins Creek and will also include future municipal reserve to be developed and dedicated with a future stage of Ardrossan East.

The proposed naming is consistent with the guidelines outlined in Strathcona County Policy Naming of Development Areas, Roads, Parks and Public Facilities.

# **Council and Committee History**

April 10, 2012 Council approved adding the name Hortonburg to the Commemorative

Names Registry.

### Other Impacts

**Policy:** SER-008-011 – Naming of development Areas, Roads, Parks & Public Facilities. **Legislative/Legal:** The *Municipal Government Act* authorizes a municipality to name parks within its boundaries.

**Interdepartmental:** The proposed park name for Ardrossan Stage 8A has been reviewed through the circulation process. No objections were received.
