Alcohol in Parks Update

Report Purpose

To provide Priorities Committee with an update on alcohol consumption in park spaces in Strathcona County.

Our Prioritized Strategic Goals

Goal 6 - Provide facilities and services that are available and accessible to residents

Report

The Parks Bylaw does not allow alcohol consumption in park spaces, but exemptions can be given, following the regulations set out by the Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis Act. Exemptions have previously been issued by the Recreation, Parks and Culture department for special events such as Highland Gathering, Ravenwood Music Festival and weddings.

Following Council's direction to investigate potential sites for alcohol consumption, there will be up to six Strathcona County pilot park sites that will allow alcohol consumption in summer 2021. Evaluation of park users' and education/enforcement experiences and feedback will occur in the fall. Based on this evaluation, future considerations will be made for the permitted use of alcohol consumption in Strathcona County parks.
