Alcohol in Parks

 Council requested administration prepare a report for options to allow alcohol consumption in Strathcona County parks.





Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis Act

- Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis sets out regulations for alcohol consumption
- The Act states for public places that:
 - a person may consume liquor in a public park in a picnic area designated by the owner or operator of the public park during the hours designated by the owner or operator if a sign is posted that
 - (a) states that a person may consume liquor in the designated picnic area,
 - (b) sets out the designated picnic area, and sets out the hours when liquor may be consumed.
 - A person must stop consuming liquor in a designated picnic area if a peace officer on reasonable and probable grounds believes that the person is intoxicated and the peace officer requests that person to stop consuming liquor.

Current Alcohol Consumption in Parks

- Exemptions have been given for special events such as:
 - Highland Gathering
 - Ravenwood Music Festival
 - Weddings





Considerations for Park and Open Space

- Site criteria includes:
 - 1. Picnic Site
 - 2. Proximity to existing recreation and park facilities
 - 3. Parking availability
 - 4. Access to the site
 - 5. Visibility from the road
 - 6. Noise for adjacent residents



- 1. Centennial Park picnic shelter and fire pits
- 2. Broadmoor Lake Park north lake picnic areas
- 3. Cloverbar Ranch Park picnic shelter
- 4. Broadmoor Lake Park Peace Park
- 5. Josephburg picnic area near pickleball courts
- 6. South Cooking Lake picnic shelter





Next Steps

- Implement signage at picnic site locations and communication plan
- Evaluate use of pilot locations
 - Feedback from people who consumed alcohol and those that did not.
 - Impact of designated alcohol consumption picnic sites on park users' overall experience
 - Public awareness of designated picnic site locations
 - Enforcement and/or complaint review
- Plan for 2022 pilot sites and/or implementation
