

Cambrian Crossing West area road naming

Report Purpose

To provide information to Council to make a decision on proposed road names within the Cambrian Crossing West neighbourhood.

Recommendation

THAT the road names for the Cambrian Crossing West area, as set out in Enclosure 3 of the July 6, 2021 Planning and Development Services Report, be approved.

Report

The developer is proposing a horse naming theme for the roadways within the western half of the Cambrian Crossing Area Structure Plan area. The developer has proposed a theme that incorporates recognition of the heritage of horses throughout Strathcona County as highlighted in the December 2013 Strathcona County Living newsletter edition (Enclosure 6). The proposed names in alphabetical order along with their meaning are listed in the table shown in Enclosure 4.

In addition to the proposed 20 horse naming themed road names, three additional road names are proposed: CAMBRIAN BOULEVARD which creates connection to the neighbourhood namesake; CRESTVIEW TERRACE which connects Cambrian crossing east and west; and BROOKSIDE DRIVE which meanders along the Pointe-Aux-Pins Creek.

The road names proposed meet the requirements of the County's naming policy.

Other Impacts

Policy: SER-008-011 – Naming of development Areas, Roads, Parks & Public Facilities. **Legislative/Legal:** The *Municipal Government Act* authorizes a municipality to name roads within its boundaries.

Interdepartmental: The proposed road names for Cambrian Crossing West have been

reviewed through the circulation process. No objections were received.
