Report Purpose

Recommendation

THAT the Council Strategic Planning Session meetings scheduled for December 1, 2021 and December 2, 2021, be cancelled; and

THAT a new Council Strategic Planning Session meeting on September 20, 2021 with a start time of 9:00 a.m. and continuing on September 24, 2021 with a start time of noon be approved; and

THAT Administration provide notice of the meeting changes to Council and to the public.
