

BYLAW 37-2021
A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 6-2015 THE LAND USE BYLAW

The *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c M-26, as amended, provides that a land use bylaw may prohibit or regulate and control the use and development of land and buildings in a municipality, and that a bylaw may be amended;

Council enacts:

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| Purpose | 1 The purpose of this bylaw is to amend Bylaw 6-2015 to incorporate recommendations from the final report of the Planning and Development Red Tape Reduction Task Force. |
| Amendments | 2 Bylaw 6-2015 is amended as follows: |
| Part 3: General Regulations | <p>(a) in section 3.10.9, "years" is deleted and replaced with "growing seasons" and "115%" is deleted and replaced with "a minimum of 50%";</p> <p>(b) in section 3.10.12, "years" is deleted and replaced with "growing seasons";</p> <p>(c) in section 3.10.13, "two (2) years" is deleted and replaced with "two (2) growing seasons";</p> <p>(d) in section 3.10.17, "years" is deleted and replaced with "growing seasons";</p> <p>(e) in section 3.14.18, "115%" is deleted and replaced with "50%";</p> |
| Part 5: Signs | <p>(f) in section 5.2.2. - the definition of ELECTRONIC MESSAGE FEATURE is deleted and replaced with the following:</p> <p>"ELECTRONIC MESSAGE FEATURE means that portion of a sign that is comprised of a device which displays text, scrolling text, characters or images. Images must be static and remain in place for a minimum of 6.0 seconds before switching to the next copy. Messages shall not include moving effects, message transition effects or videos"</p> |
