Report Purpose

To provide information to Council to make a decision on first, second and third readings of a bylaw that proposes to amend Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 by rezoning approximately 7.14 hectares (17.66 acres) within Pt. of SW 11-53-22-W4 from PR - Recreation to RE - Estate Residential; R1A - Single Detached Residential A; PC - Conservation and PU - Public Utilities in accordance with the Ardrossan Area Structure Plan (ASP).

Recommendations

- THAT Bylaw 56-2021, a bylaw that amends Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 by rezoning approximately 7.14 hectares (17.66 acres) within Pt. of SW 11-53-22-W4 from PR -Recreation to RE - Estate Residential District; R1A - Single Detached Residential A; PC -Conservation and PU - Public Utilities, be given first reading.

Report

The proposed rezoning is in support of a concurrently proposed subdivision application for Ardrossan Estates Stage 4, consisting of 16 RE - Estate Residential lots; 34 R1A - Single Detached Residential A lots; as well as environmental reserve and public utility lots.

The proposed rezoning is within the Medium and Large Lot Residential Areas within the Ardrossan ASP and is consistent with the policies for the Medium and Large Lot Residential Areas.
