

**Bylaw 33-2022 Road Closure (Ward 4)****Report Purpose**

To give three readings to a bylaw that proposes the closure of a portion of Road Plan 1521457 to support development by creating additional pedestrian and recreational trail linkages.

**Recommendation**

1. THAT Bylaw 33-2022, a bylaw that proposes the closure of a portion of Road Plan 1521457, be given first reading.
2. THAT Bylaw 33-2022 be given second reading.
3. THAT Bylaw 33-2022 be considered for third reading.
4. THAT Bylaw 33-2022 be given third reading.

**Report**

The proposed road closure is in support of concurrent rezoning and subdivision applications which propose to redesignate the road closure area into municipal reserve for a multi-use trail in the Summerwood neighbourhood in accordance with the Summerwood ASP.

The public hearing will provide members of the public the opportunity to provide comments directly to Council prior to a decision on proposed Bylaw 33-2022.
