Policy GOV-001-032 Council Priority Fund Expenditures – Revisions to Policy

Report Purpose

This report provides a revised draft of policy GOV-001-032 Council Priority Fund Expenditures for Council approval.

Recommendation

THAT revised Policy GOV-001-032 Council Priority Fund Expenditures, as set out in enclosure 1 of the July 5, 2022 Governance Advisory Committee report, be approved.

Report

On April 20, 2022, the Governance Advisory Committee (GAC) reviewed and discussed initial revisions to policy GOV-001-032 Council Priority Fund Expenditures. A revised draft was brought forward to the May 16, 2022 GAC meeting for further discussion and feedback.

Highlights of the proposed changes to the policy include:

- A requirement to enter into a grant agreement with Strathcona County.
- Clarification that funds can not be used for out of County travel, including meals, lodging and extraneous expenses.
- Clarification that funds can not be used for assets that benefit an individual and that assets must remain a possession of the group or organization (such as sports equipment, uniforms, etc.).
- A provision to match increases to the overall Priority Fund budget to the previous year's Consumer Price index (CPI) yearly inflation rate.
- A revised Policy Statement to highlight the guiding principle that Council Priority Funds are meant to support community-based initiatives or events that benefit Strathcona County and its residents.
- A preference to provide capital project funding to groups that have not received funds for a capital project within the last four years.

Administration provided input and feedback on the suggested changes and are supportive of the revisions.
