

Bylaw 38-2022 - text amendment to AR - Agriculture River Valley District in Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 (Ward 5)

Report Purpose

To provide information to Council to make decisions on first, second and third readings on a bylaw that proposes to amend the text of the AR – Agriculture: River Valley zoning district of Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 to include "utility service, major" as a discretionary use, specifically for renewable energy development within the Environmental Policy Area of the Heartland Industrial Area Structure Plan.

Recommendations

- 1. THAT Bylaw 38-2022, a bylaw that amends the text of the AR Agriculture: River Valley zoning district of Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 to:
 - a. include "utility service, major" as a discretionary use; and
 - b. add fundamental use criteria that limits a utility service, major use to renewable energy development within the Environmental Policy Area of the Heartland Industrial Area Structure Plan,

be given first reading.

- 2. THAT Bylaw 38-2022 be given second reading.
- 3. THAT Bylaw 38-2022 be considered for third reading.
- 4. THAT Bylaw 38-2022 be given third reading.

Report

Bylaw 38-2022 is being brought forward concurrently with the proposed amendment to the Heartland Industrial Area Structure Plan (ASP) Bylaw 37-2022. Proposed amendments to the AR – Agriculture: River Valley zoning district are intended to align the district with the policies of the updated Heartland Industrial ASP.

The proposed amendment will include "utility service, major" as a discretionary use in the AR – Agriculture: River Valley zoning district and include a provision in the fundamental use criteria that development permit applications for a "utility service, major" use shall be limited to renewable energy development within the Environmental Policy Area of the Heartland Industrial ASP.
