

BYLAW 50-2022
CONVERSION THERAPY PROHIBITION BYLAW REPEALING BYLAW

Council condemns the forced use of conversion therapy to attempt to change a person's sexual orientation, gender identity, gender preference, or gender expression; and

Bill C-4, *An Act to amend the Criminal Code* (conversion therapy) received Royal Assent on December 8, 2021, and came into effect on January 7, 2022, making it illegal to provide, promote and profit off conversation therapy; and

Strathcona County's *Conversion Therapy Prohibition Bylaw* is superseded by the amendments to the *Criminal Code*.

Therefore Council enacts:
