3.2 Bylaw 49-2022 Map Amendment to Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 (Ward 3)

THAT Bylaw 49-2022, a bylaw that amends Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 by rezoning approximately 8.27 hectares (20.44 acres) of land within Lots 1 and 2, Plan 8720616 from DC2 – Direct Control zoning district to R1C - Single Detached Residential C zoning district; R2A - Semi-Detached Residential zoning district; R2C - Lane Specific Residential zoning district; R3 - Low to Medium Density Multiple Residential zoning district; PR – Recreation zoning district; PU – Public Utilities zoning district; and PC - Conservation zoning district, be given third reading.
