

## Motion following Notice of Motion - Commemorative Names Registry Task Force

- THAT Administration prepare, for Council's consideration by the end of Q2 2023, updates to Council Policy SER 008-011 The Naming of Development Areas, Roads, Parks and Public Facilities, the updates to include adding considerations for Indigenous naming; and
- 2. THAT by the end of October 2022, Administration prepare, for Council's consideration, a bylaw and any necessary documents for the establishment of a Council Advisory Task Force, with a proposed membership of 5-7 public members, one Councillor, one alternate and the Mayor as an *ex-officio* member for the following purposes:
  - a) to review the current Strathcona County Commemorative Names Registry and investigate and propose additional people that should be added to the Strathcona County Commemorative Names Registry,
  - b) to work with Administration on the proposed updates to the commemorative names registry portion of Policy SER 008-011, and
  - c) to return to Council by the end of Q2 2023, with names and brief biographies of proposed additions to the Commemorative Names Registry.
