

Enforcement Services Patrol Data

Please provide information on the number of times Enforcement Services has, over the past year, patrolled residential areas that are not specific school or playground zone traffic enforcement operations.

Peace Officers are assigned specific patrol areas throughout Strathcona County. Officer presence and crime deterrence is a critical component of community safety and well-being. The Annual Policing Priorities survey completed in January 2022 identified crime prevention and community patrols as the number one priority for the County's Peace Officers. The [Enforcement Services Proactive Patrols Map](#) is a public link that shows the frequency and locations where Enforcement Services has had a visible presence in Strathcona County's urban and rural neighbourhoods. 17,197 patrols were completed from August 2021 to August 2022. 8,116 patrols were completed in rural subdivisions and the remaining 9,081 were completed in urban residential areas inclusive of County facilities, parks, playgrounds, and schools.
