The Half Moon Lake Residents Association is a non-profit Association registered in the Province of Alberta. The membership of the Association is made up of Half Moon Lake Hamlet Residents and Half Moon Lake Estates residents and all residents who abut the lake.

Located in the County of Strathcona, the purpose of the Half Moon Lake Residents' Association, in accordance with it's bylaws, is to facilitate cooperative community planning that fosters good will among residents, to provide common voice and a democratic forum for community issues and to conserve the benefits of our semi-rural and lake environment that will enhance our lifestyle at Half Moon Lake.

The rural area of Half Moon Lake has experienced vandalism break ins and public trespassing through the Hamlet into the local Resort. In an effort to stop this from happening and work with local RCMP to capture these criminals; the Half Moon Lake Residents Association developed a Project as part of it's neighborhood watch program to install security cameras.

There was to be a total of 8 cameras to be installed at four(4) locations. A preliminary layout for these cameras is attached herein. In 2020 the County approved funding for three of the four locations for the installation of these cameras and three sets of cameras has since been installed. This request is for completion of the fourth installation.

The cameras are installed on Residents Properties at locations 1, 2 and 3 adjacent to the street. As per our original plan the first three cameras were installed and we have already collaborated with the RCMP to deal with a trespassing incident in the community. We have observed no break ins since the cameras have been installed.

The current Project Budget for this excluding community labor for installation is \$7,000. This is a verbal quote provided by the original contractor who installed the first three sets of cameras for us after a competitive bid process that the Association went through to select the first three installations. The budget plan for this installation will be for the Association to fund raise to collect \$3500 for half of the installation and we are asking for the County to raise the other half \$3500 of the installation, for a total of \$7000. Residents time for helping with installation will be donated by the Residents at no cost.

The costs for power Installation and ongoing operating power costs will be covered by Residents Association. The ask represents half of the value of the installation of the Cameras. The Residents Association will cover the remaining portion of the installation of this Project.
