

Strathcona County Design and Construction Standards – Wastewater Lift Stations (New)**Report Purpose**

A new Wastewater Lift Stations Standard section has been drafted and supported by the Urban Development Institute to be included into the Strathcona County Design and Construction Standards. This section outlines the standard requirements for designing and constructing wastewater lift stations within Strathcona County. UDI has provided a letter of support (Enclosure 1) for the proposed additions. Upon Council approval, the proposed Wastewater Lift Stations section (Enclosure 2) will be added to the existing Strathcona County Design and Construction Standards document.
