BYLAW 6-2018

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE SPEED CONTROL BYLAW, 38-2014 AMENDMENT NO. 1

WHEREAS section 107(3) the *Traffic Safety Act*, RSA 2000, c. T-6, and regulations made thereunder, provide that a Municipality may enact to set the times that reduced speed limits in school zones are in effect; and

WHEREAS Bylaw 38-2014, the *Speed Control Bylaw*, establishes speed limits in school zones on school days; and

WHEREAS Strathcona County wishes to amend the times that the speed limits in school zones are in effect;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF STRATHCONA COUNTY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 3.4 of Bylaw 38-2014, the *Speed Control Bylaw*, is amended by deleting the entire section and replacing it with:
 - On a Highway or a portion of a Highway identified as a school zone by a traffic control device, a speed limit of thirty (30) kilometers per hour is in effect on any day that school is held, between 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
- 2. This Bylaw comes into force on September 1, 2018.

Read a third time this this 27th day of February, A.D. 2018 and finally passed.
