Commemorative Names Registry Task Force



Mandate

The mandate of the task force is to:

- a. review the current Strathcona County Commemorative Names Registry and investigate and propose additional people that should be added to the Strathcona County Commemorative Names Registry,
- b. work with Administration on the proposed updates to the commemorative names registry portion of Policy SER 008-011, and
- c. return to Council by the end of Q2 2023, with names and brief biographies of proposed additions to the Commemorative Names Registry.



Membership

The proposed composition for the task force is:

- Five to seven public members
- One councillor (and one Councillor as alternate)
- The Mayor as an ex-officio member

The Governance Advisory Committee will conduct the public member interviews and make recommendations to Council for final appointments.



Timeline

If Bylaw 56-2022 receives three readings,

administration will proceed with recruitment immediately so that appointments can be made in January 2023.

The task force will be in place until the final report has been presented to Council, which has a due date of the end of the second quarter of 2023.
