

Naming of Cambrian Crossing West's stormwater management facilities, parks and road renaming (Ward 4)

Report Purpose

To provide information to Council to make a decision on proposed names for stormwater management facilities, parks and road renaming within the Cambrian Crossing West neighbourhood.

Recommendation

THAT the names for stormwater management facilities, parks and road renaming for the Cambrian Crossing West area, as set out in Enclosure 3 of the November 15, 2022, Planning and Development Services report, be approved.

The developer is proposing names for the stormwater management facilities and parks as well as the renaming of two roads within the Cambrian Crossing West neighbourhood.

The proposed stormwater management facilities and park names are named after a road they are adjacent to.

The developer is also proposing to rename "Colonial Bay" to "Cadence Bay" and "Cuddie Court" and "Cob View" to proposed realigned road "Cuddie Drive" as shown in attached Enclosure 3.

All the proposed names are in accordance with County policy SER-008-011 Naming of Development Areas, Roads, Parks and Public Facilities.

July 6, 2021 Council approved the Cambrian Crossing West road names.
