

Bylaw 55-2022, Amending Bylaw to Bylaw 36-2020 - Winfield Heights Rural Water Service Local Improvement Levy Bylaw

Report Purpose

To seek first, second and third reading to Bylaw 55-2022, a bylaw to amend the Winfield Heights – Rural Water Service Local Improvement Tax Levy Bylaw 36-2020.

Report

Bylaw 36-2020 reflected the estimated project costs, the total number of properties to benefit from the Winfield Heights low pressure trickle system project, and the projected borrowing rate for the debenture that would be issued to finance the project.

The project is now complete and the exact number of benefiting owners who wish to pay their share of the costs over time has been determined; and the debenture to finance the project has been issued.

Council and Committee History

July 19, 2022	Council approved Bylaw 40-2022, a bylaw to increase the maximum interest rate in Part II Section 4 from FIVE (5) percent to SIX (6) percent.
March 22, 2022	Council approved Bylaw 7-2022, a bylaw to increase the maximum interest rate in Part II Section 4 from TWO AND SIX-TENTHS (2.6) percent to FIVE (5.0) percent.
July 21, 2020	Council approved Bylaw 37-2020, a bylaw to authorize the Council of Strathcona County to incur indebtedness by the issuance of debenture(s) in the amount of \$452,375 for the purpose of financing the design and construction of a low-pressure trickle system for the residents of Winfield Heights.
July 21, 2020	Council approved Bylaw 36-2020, a bylaw to authorize a local improvement tax levy to pay for the Winfield Heights low-pressure trickle system.
