Council was provided with recommendations on the Council Committee structure on September 27, 2022 and provided direction to Administration to prepare an amending bylaw to extend the sunset date of the Accessibility Advisory Committee and the Seniors Advisory Committee to the end of 2023.

Bylaw 60-2022 amends the establishing bylaw for each committee to replace the repeal dates of December 31, 2022 with December 31, 2023. Recruitment for both committees to fill vacancies for 2023 took place throughout October and November, with appointments expected to be made by Council on December 6, 2022.
