## Response:

Fleet and Facility Management provides an annual operating grant to each community hall and senior center's licensed user association. The amount of the grant allocated to each facility is based on the total grant amount divided by the square footage of each hall.

For 2023 the budget includes \$82,000 that would be distributed on the same ratio as provided for the 2022 payment amount shown in the table below.

With the proposed increase by 15%, the table shows what each group would receive based on the total increase of the grant to \$94,300 and allocated as noted above.

This increase of 15% would be considered a one time increase and can be funded from the following options;

- Increase tax requirement
- Reserve fund
- Absorb (if absorbed, funding to other program areas would be negatively impacted by the \$12,300 increase to the operating grant).
