In our fundraising efforts, we are requesting funding through the Council Priority Funds Program to assist in covering expenses for hosting the event. We expect approximately 95 graduates to attend. Our venue has been generously donated by a graduate's family. However there are still several costs in hosting the event. The funds received would help to cover the following expenses:
