Youth Diversion

- Since January 2023 there have been 20 referrals.
- Program usually takes 3 months to complete but can be extended.
- There was 635 hours of community service completed within Strathcona County last year.
- Youth Justice completed exit interviews and received the following responses:
 - ❖ *One of the managers from Hodge Podge Lodge, where a youth completed 25 hours of community service said that the youth was wonderful to work with and all the other volunteers want him to come back.*
 - ❖ *Another youth's mom told Youth Justice that her daughter is doing great in the Program and is actually sad to be finished her community service hours as she really enjoyed them and is going to see if they will let her continue volunteering. The Mom is so happy there is a program for kids who get into trouble as she sees YJ making a difference with her daughter*



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Bike Patrol

- Four members bike trained in May.
- Partnership with Enforcement Services Bike Patrol.
- Trucks equipped to carry bikes so front line members can complete patrols while out in the community.

Mail Theft Project

- Project ran from February 28 to March 4 attempting to address mail theft.
- High theft areas were determined and tracking devices installed in mailboxes.
- Surveillance completed in high crime areas.
- Developed good contacts and established best practices from project.



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Crime Mapping

- Crime mapping date will be published in the Strathcona newspaper quarterly.
- Is in partnership with Strathcona County Crime Watch.
- June 15th is first publication with data from May 31st.



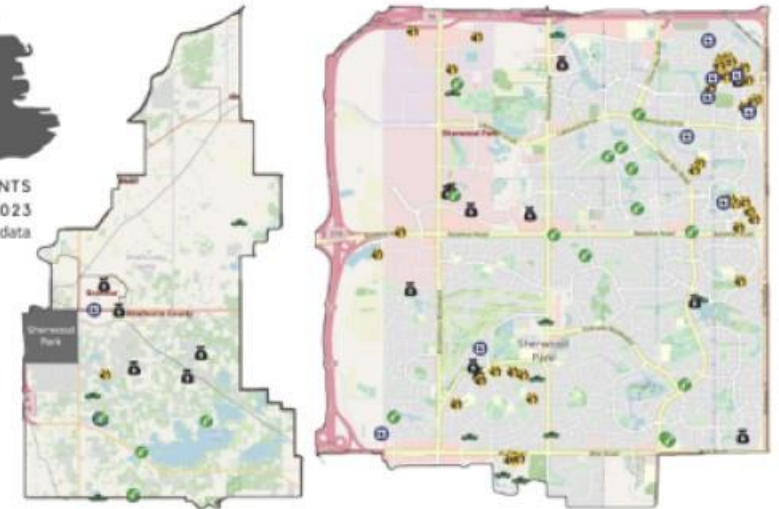
MAP REPRESENTS

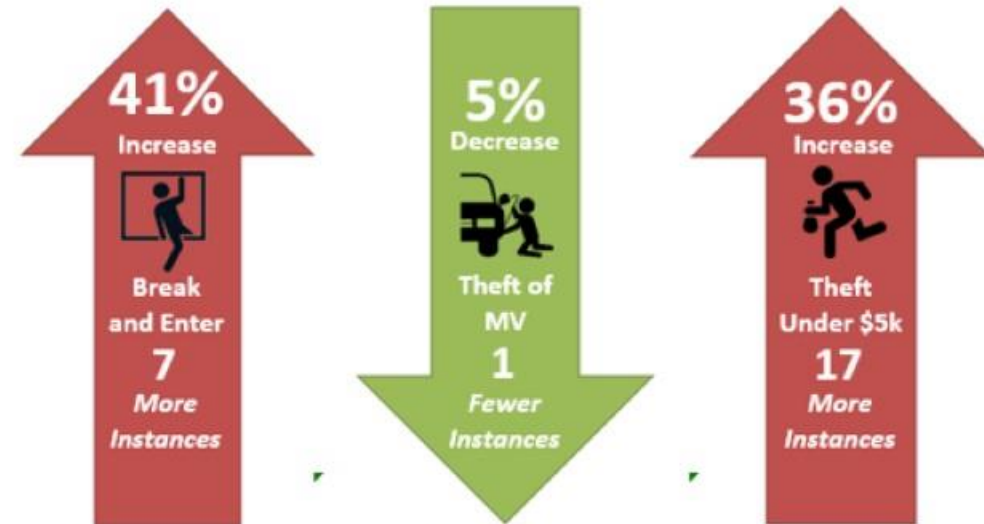
