Mildred Stefiszyn shared her infectious energy with everyone she met. Her life was grounded in the landscape, the history, and the people of the Cooking Lake moraine. Pioneer family roots run deep and Mildred cherished, nourished, and shared hers willingly.

Her most tangible legacy is Land among the Lakes: A History of the Deville and North Cooking Lake Area, a title that Mildred herself suggested for a cross-Canada historical book project that compiled a written record of the stories, efforts, and lives of local residents over the previous 100 years. Mildred, supported by her husband Bill, was a driving force in every aspect of gathering, collating, and documenting information provided in this historic effort. The book serves as a legacy of personal stories and pictures of local long-term pioneers and residents, and their life on the moraine over many decades.
