

BYLAW 26-2023
BOARDS AND COMMITTEES HONORARIUM AMENDING BYLAW NO. 2

The *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000 c M-26, provides that a council may pass bylaws in relation to the establishment and function of council committees, prescribe rules for their conduct and procedure, and that bylaws may be amended;

Council adopted Bylaw 34-2017 to establish the honoraria to be payable to public members of Council Committees; and

It is desirable to amend Bylaw 34-2017 to delete and replace Schedule "A" to the bylaw to encompass the honoraria for all established Council Committees;
