Project Background

In October 2022, Council provided direction that:

- 1. the project plan and scope be confirmed; and
- 2. the progressive design-build procurement for the Pointe-aux-Pins Acres should provisionally include a concrete floor and building space for animal housing.

- The long-standing vision for an agricultural facility was driven by the expressed need for agricultural recreation space in the community.
- The need was identified in several County documents and through extensive research and community consultation with residents and community groups.
- The location was selected based on synergies with the Bremner Heritage Site in rural Strathcona County.

Estimated operating budget

Building Changes

Site Changes

- Decrease area of site development ۲
- Remove campground and amenities and roadways ۲
- Connection to Capital Region Northwest Water Services Commission ۲ watermain
 - Remove onsite potable water reservoir
 - Remove fire pumphouse and non potable water system
- Remove covered riding arena ۲
- Revised parking and roadways to support new building design ullet
