Report

Strathcona County Transit is beginning its review and update to the Transit Master Plan. The Transit Master Plan was adopted in 2019, prior to the pandemic. This mid-term review will research how the pandemic has impacted our residents travel patterns for commuter and local transit and what changes may be needed. This update will also review our transit infrastructure and fleet needs as we consider the future of transit and mobility in our community. Dillion Consulting has been brought on board for the project to complete the background review, analysis and recommendations, implementation and the final TMP update document. Three rounds of engagement are planned with stakeholders, internal staff, transit riders and the public. The project is expected to last 18 months and should be finalized by the fall of 2024 for Council's review and approval. Additional information is provided in the attached PowerPoint presentation.
