Dear Members of Strathcona County Council,

Thank you for your consideration of our application for the Council Priority Fund grant. The Strathcona Christmas Bureau was established in 1979 and is run by a volunteer Board of Directors. Each year the Strathcona Christmas Bureau provides grocery certificates and gifts for disadvantaged families who are struggling during the Christmas season.
