

Bylaw 20-2023 Road Closure (Ward 7)

Report Purpose

The purpose of proposed Bylaw 20-2023 is to consider the closure of a part of Road Plans 6208NY, 1026558, 4899TR and Original Government Road Allowance. The portions of road being considered for closure are undeveloped and will be consolidated into the adjacent parcels.

Recommendations

- 1. THAT Bylaw 20-2023, a bylaw the proposes the closure of a part of Road Plans 6208NY, 1026558, 4899TR and Original Government Road Allowance within SE 4-52-22-W4, be given first reading.
- 2. THAT Bylaw 20-2023 be given second reading.
- 3. THAT Bylaw 20-2023 be considered for third reading.
- 4. THAT Bylaw 20-2023 be given third reading.

Report

The purpose of the proposed bylaw is to close the undeveloped portions of Township Road 520 associated with the completed reconstruction of Township Road 520. The proposed road closure lands are intended to be consolidated into adjacent parcels that have been identified through land agreements including a portion being transferred to Alberta Environment and Parks in compliance with our environmental approvals and reclamation plan. The undeveloped portions of road are not required and can be closed.

In support of the Township Road 520 reconstruction, Council previously adopted Bylaw 35-2012 for the closure of a portion of the Original Government Road Allowance within the SE 4-52-22-W4. The completion of the Township Road 520 reconstruction project has resulted in identification of additional portions of adjacent road plans not required and were not included in Bylaw 35-2012. Proposed Bylaw 20-2023 will repeal previously adopted Bylaw 35-2012.

June 26, 2012 Council adopted road closure Bylaw 35-2012.
