### Report

The function of the Art Collection Advisory Committee is to guide selection of art acquisitions for Strathcona County's Art Collection through the development of the guidelines and criteria. The selection panel which has both Advisory Committee members and local artists recommend the pieces to be added to the permanent collection.

This year, 47 artists submitted artwork for a total of 74 artworks from adults. In the youth category there were 88 artworks submitted by 61 students at the Art Society of Strathcona County's "High School Student Art Competition, Show and Sale" at the Red Barn.

The recommended purchases for the 2023 Annual Art Acquisition program totals \$10,821. This amount will be provided through the operational budget for 2023.

# **Council and Committee History**

July 8, 2014 Council approved the Strathcona County Public Art Plan. Thereafter, the

Permanent Art Collection Committee is known as the Art Collection

Advisory Committee.

October 20, 1987 Council approved the Terms of Reference for the Strathcona County

Permanent Art Collection Committee (Resolution #1097/87). The Committee as made recommendations annually for the purchase of

artworks.
