

Bylaw 38-2023 Map Amendment to Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 (Ward 6)

Report Purpose

To provide information to Council to make decisions on first, second and third readings of a proposed bylaw that amends Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 by rezoning approximately 64.47 hectares (159.31 acres) of land within the NE 8-51-22-W4 to RA – Rural Residential/Agriculture in accordance with the Agriculture Small Holdings Policy Area of the Municipal Development Plan.

Recommendations

1. THAT Bylaw 38-2023, a bylaw that amends Land Use Bylaw 6-2015 by rezoning approximately 64.47 hectares (159.31 acres) of land within the NE 8-51-22-W4 from AG – Agriculture: General to RA – Rural Residential/Agriculture, be given first reading.
2. THAT Bylaw 38-2023 be given second reading.
3. THAT Bylaw 38-2023 be considered for third reading.
4. THAT Bylaw 38-2023 be given third reading.

The applicant has proposed the rezoning to RA – Rural Residential/Agriculture in support of a concurrently proposed subdivision of the subject parcel to create a total of four agriculture residential lots in the quarter section.

The subject property is located within the Agriculture Small Holdings Policy Area of the Municipal Development Plan. The proposed rezoning and subdivision are consistent with the policies of the Agriculture Small Holdings Policy Area and the regulations of the RA – Rural Residential/Agriculture zoning district of the Land Use Bylaw.
