THAT an amendment to the 2020 Capital Budget for a change in funding (only) for The Pointe – Building Construction project from \$3,000,000 Municipal Reserves, \$8,500,000 MSI Grant, and \$4,000,000 CCBF Grant to \$15,500,000 from Tax Rate Supported Debenture, be approved.
