## **Report Purpose**

The purpose of the Seniors Advisory Committee (SAC) is to provide advice and considerations to Council on issues and opportunities related to the physical, emotional and social well-being of seniors in Strathcona County. The SAC's workplan is aligned with Strathcona County Council's Strategic Plan and the County's key strategies and policies. The SAC provides a seniors' lens on Strathcona County policies, programs and services and provides advice to Council and administration on policies and programs to improve outcomes for seniors in Strathcona County.
