- Murder/Body Dump in rural Strathcona County Edmonton Major Crimes and Strathcona GIS continue to investigate July
- Cyber Crime Fraud 63 year old woman was defrauded of \$340,000 by gaining access to her computer, investigation ongoing August
- ➤ Car Dealership Vehicle Fraud Man attempted to purchase vehicle by putting deposit of \$15k on Mastercard that was not his and have vehicle delivered to Lloydminster, using undercover operation man was arrested and charged and also in possession of another stolen vehicle August
- ➤ Criminal Flight in Stolen Vehicle (Roll over Death) Driver of stolen vehicle out of Edmonton rolled his vehicle after spike belt deployment September
- > Stolen Vehicle/Robbery/Intimidation Four youth stole a vehicle in St. Albert and assaulted and robbed a youth in Sherwood Park, suspects arrested September


New RCMP Complaint Line Phone Number

- New Province wide combined complaint line number being rolled out on December 4th, 2023.
- \triangleright New number is 310-RCMP(7267).
- ➤ When anyone in the province calls this number, they will get a phone tree. The menu option will ask (French/English) first, then press 1 for Lloydminster, 2 for St Albert, 3 for Strathcona County and 4 for everywhere else.
- ➤ Calls will then be transferred to the appropriate Operational Communications Centre (OCC).






Response Times – Municipal (2022)

- The graph below shows a break down of all of these calls.




- ➤ The overall average response time for Priority 1 & 2 calls in 2022 for the Strathcona Municipal Detachment was 13.4 minutes.
- The graph below shows a break down of all of these calls.






Response Times – Provincial (2022)
