

Borrowing Bylaw 40-2023 - Pointe-Aux-Pins Acres Agriculture Facility Building Construction - Second and Third Readings

Report Purpose

To give second and third readings to a borrowing bylaw for the Pointe-Aux-Pins Acres Agriculture Facility Building construction.

Recommendations

THAT Bylaw 40-2023, a bylaw to approve the incurrence of debt for the Pointe-Aux-Pins Acres Agriculture Facility Building construction, be given second reading.

THAT Bylaw 40-2023 be given third reading

Report

The County is facing unprecedented challenges in maintaining and upgrading its infrastructure such as roads, bridges and buildings due to the impact of economic conditions. Increased inflation has placed pressure on County reserves used to support our annual capital programs and fund the maintenance and renewal of our existing assets. To address this situation, the County is speeding up its plan (which began last year) to increase its reserves and achieve a healthy balance between available funding and spending.

Refinancing the Pointe-Aux-Pins Acres Agriculture Facility Building construction project with debt allows the County the opportunity to reallocate \$18.3 million of reserve and grant funding to other projects. This will help the County make the most of its capital plan and safeguard reserves from excessive pressure. The other option would be to raise taxes and/or cut services in the near future to keep the reserves at a sustainable level.

Tax supported Borrowing Bylaw 40-2023 for up to \$18,321,000 will enable the completion of the Pointe-Aux-Pins Acres Agriculture Facility Building construction project as approved by Council. The *Municipal Government Act* (MGA) indicates that a municipality may only make a borrowing if the borrowing is authorized by a borrowing bylaw, and bylaws must be given three readings by Council in order to be passed.

This bylaw pertains to the Pointe-Aux-Pins Acres Agriculture Facility Building Construction Project only. Construction of the building has not started. This bylaw was advertised for the required petition period per the *Municipal Government Act*, and no petitions were received.
